

## Jalsa Musleh Maud (r.a)

### Brisbane

By the Grace of Almighty Allah, Jamaat Ahmadiyya Brisbane organised Jalsa Musleh Maud (r.a.) day on Sunday the 24<sup>th</sup> of February 2008. This year the Jalsa was part of the Centenary Khilafat Jubilee celebrations and Jamaat Ahmadiyya Brisbane celebrated this day in its traditional glory.

The proceedings of the Jalsa were presided by President Jamaat Ahmadiyya Brisbane, Abdul Maqbool Latif. The total attendance in the Jalsa was 97 consisting of 29 Khuddam, 22 Atfal, 12 Ansaar, 21 Lajna and 13 Nasiraat.

The first session of the program started with the recitation from the Holy Quran by Mudassar Mahmood followed by its translation. After that Nasir Sharma read a beautiful poem. President Jamaat then delivered a welcome speech in which he highlighted the importance of this celebrating this day. The second speech in the program was by Murabbi Sahib, Maulana Masood Ahmad Shahid. Murabbi Sahib spoke about the details of prophecy about Musleh Maud (r.a.), it's background, Hadhrat Masih Maud's (a.s) visit to Hushiyarpur and how this prophecy was fulfilled. Then Muzaffar Khan delivered a speech on the life of Hadhrat Musleh Maud (r.a.). The first session was finished on a tea break.

The second session began with a poem by Naveed Nasir. Then Mohammad Arif (Nazim Atfal) read out Hadhrat Musleh Maud's (r.a.) instruction to Atfal-ul-Ahmadiyya. The last speech of the program was delivered by Syed Mubarak Ahmad on the topic of "Formation of Auxiliary Organisation by Hadhrat Musleh Maud (r.a.). In the end Murabbi Sahib led silent prayers and the program came to a conclusion.
